Communication no 5 about the Coronavirus COVID -19 - 4 November 2020

Following the announcement of a four-week lockdown in England from Thursday 5 November, the National Youth Agency (NYA) has now issued guidance about what this means for all youth sector activity.

From 5 November Scouts and all other youth activities will move to Red readiness level. This decision by the Government means that there can be no face-to-face activity with young people or adult volunteers. Only virtual meetings can take place until further notice.

In Scotland and Wales local government rules continue to apply.
